



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 12/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow amounts are not expected to be significant but weakly bonded localised deposits will be present mainly above 900 metres. The greatest accumulations of instabilities will be on North-East through to South-East aspects. Sheltered gullies and scarp slopes will be most affected. Elsewhere the snowpack will refreeze and be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers with moderate North-Westerly winds will continue through the reporting period. These conditions may be occasional and isolated at times. The freezing level will lower to 750 metres.

Comments

Summit temperatures expected to be around -3c this will help improve climbing conditions.
