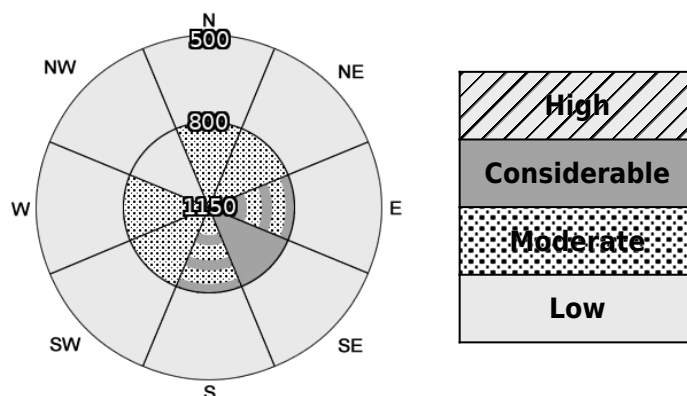


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 12/03/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Unstable windslab will develop on mainly East to Southerly aspects above 800 meters where avalanches are likely. Elsewhere the moist snowpack will refreeze and become generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be strong North-Westerly winds with snow showers which will tend to die out through Friday. Overnight the freezing level will be at 900 metres lowering to 750 metres in the day.

Good travel conditions although there are large areas of compacted and frozen sastrugi which make ski descents interesting.
