

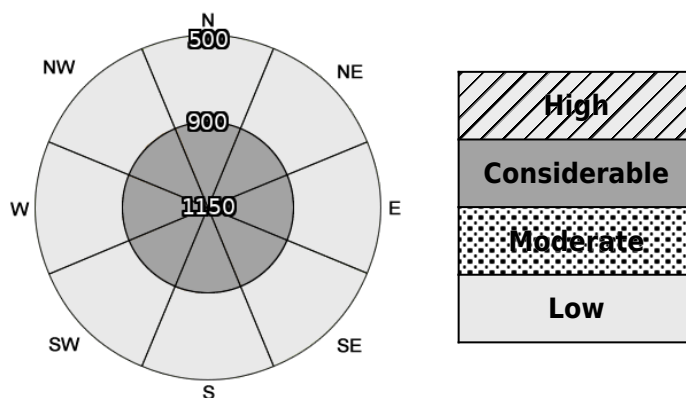
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 16/03/2010

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The deeper snowpack (down about half a metre on south aspects) is still dry and stable. Closer to the surface the snowpack is moist. On crags and steep ground loose snow avalanches are likely above 900 metres on all aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It is forecast to be dry on Tuesday with moderate westerly winds and freezing levels still near the tops.

#### Comments

Major warming forecast with rain later in the week. Watch for glide cracks and possible deeper releases due to extensive distribution of exceptional depth of snowpack.
