

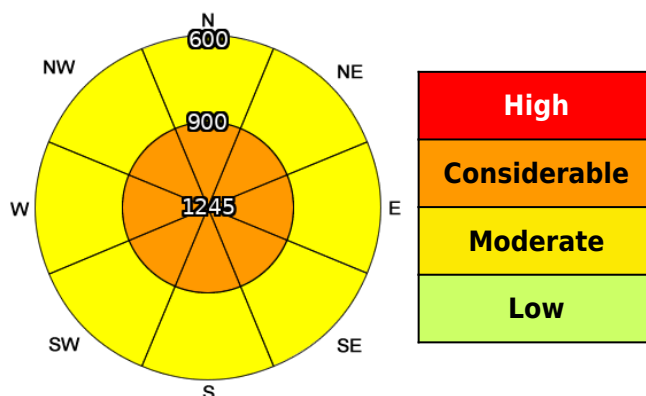

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will thaw rapidly and will become saturated. Surface and deeper instabilities are likely to produce wet avalanches on all steep aspects mainly above 900 metres. Cornices will collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain at all levels is expected overnight and during the day. Winds will be strong South-Westerly. The freezing level will be at 1900 metres.

Very strong winds and thawing conditions ahead.
