

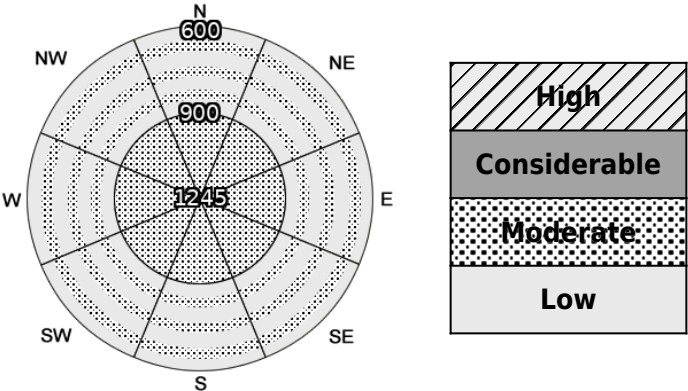

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 20/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The thaw will continue at all but the highest altitudes. Snowpack instabilities will remain on all aspects above 900 metres in areas of steep terrain. Localised instabilities will affect the steepest slopes below this level. Small, accumulations of windslab are expected to develop on North-East through East to South aspects above 800 metres. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will become slightly cooler as the freezing level lowers to just below the summits. Occasional light snow showers will develop on moderate West-North-West winds.

Comments

Some large cornices overhanging N Corries. Potential for loose rocks on routes and rockfall in thaw conditions.
