

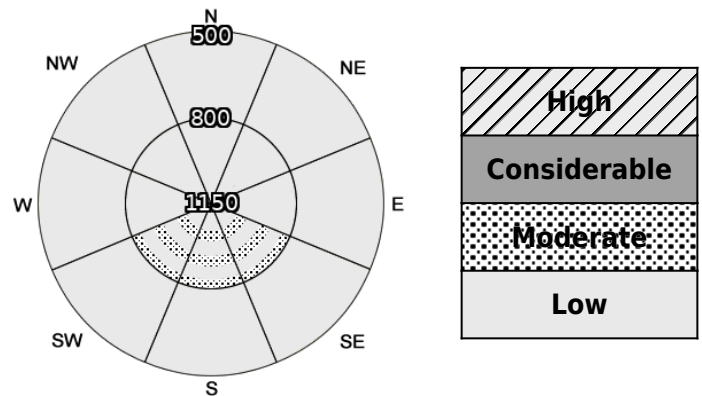

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The melt freeze cycle is contributing to a more gradual transition for the late winter snowpack. Extended and overhanging cornices continue to be weak. The deeper snowpack is reasonably stable. Surface instabilities will be more localized on Southerly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

There is no precipitation forecast for the period. Winds will be light from West-north-west then South-West on Sunday. Overnight temperatures will drop below freezing.

Comments

Early morning icy sections will soften up on the first day of spring.
