

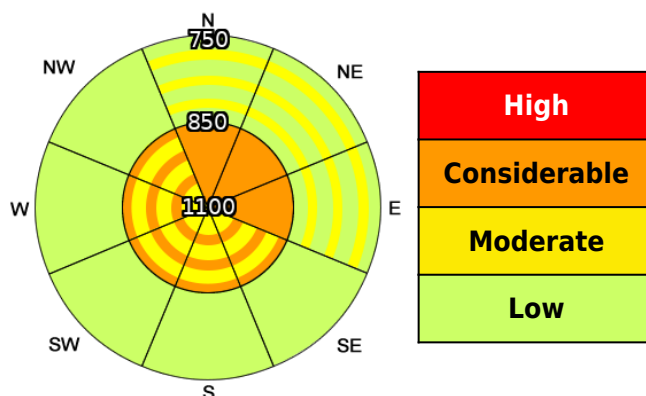

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 22/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will be present on steep slopes on all aspects. Fresh poorly bonded windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies and hollows and on mainly North to East aspects above around 850 metres. Cornices will be prone to spontaneous collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight rain at all levels will become heavy before clearing during the morning. Snow showers are then expected above 750 metres on strong South-West winds. The freezing level is expected to drop from 1400 metres overnight to around 1100 metres during the day.

Comments

Rock and ice fall remain a potential hazard during thaw conditions.
