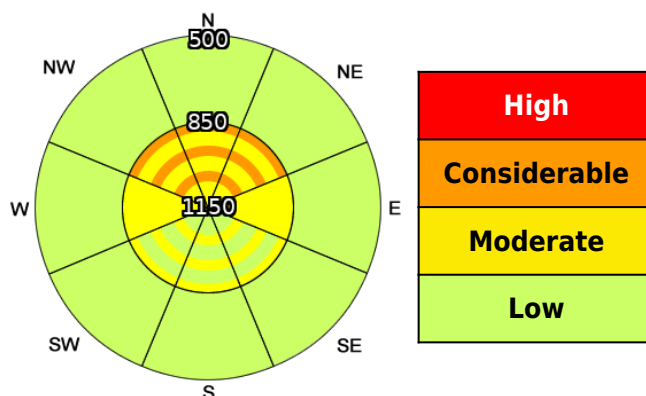

Isolated pockets of new wind slab instability will develop on Northerly aspects above 850 metres. Overhanging and extended cornices are still prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Snow will only lie on the higher terrain, above about 850 metres. Winds will be from the South, initially light increasing to moderate.

Comments

The gradual transition to late winter continues with good diurnal range of temperatures. Nice and easy to avoid any nasty spring surprise.
