

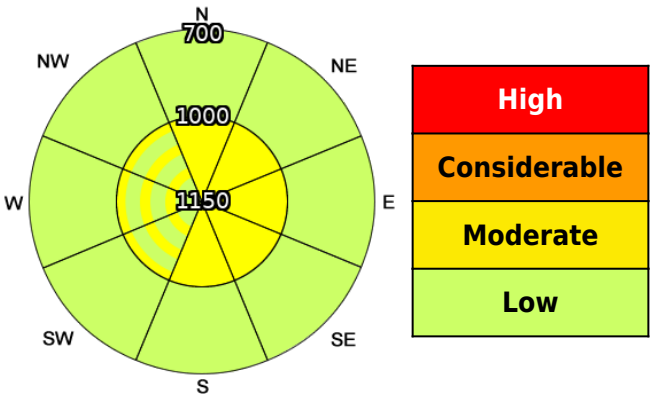

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 26/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack is well consolidated and will remain generally stable. Through the day, and in the afternoon especially, areas of soft, wet and poorly bonded windslab will be deposited on North through East to South aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a wet night with rain falling at all levels. The rain will continue through the day, but from about midday the temperature will drop, and the rain will begin to turn to wet snow above 1000 metres. Light South-Westerly winds will veer North-Westerly and strengthen.
