



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deep accumulations of unstable windslab will be present on many aspects but mainly on East, through South and West to North-West aspects above 600 metres where avalanches will occur. On the same aspects below 600 metres, unstable localised windslab deposits will also be present. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snowfall is expected to low levels overnight and during the day with very strong Northerly winds. The freezing level is expected to be around 350 metres during the day.
