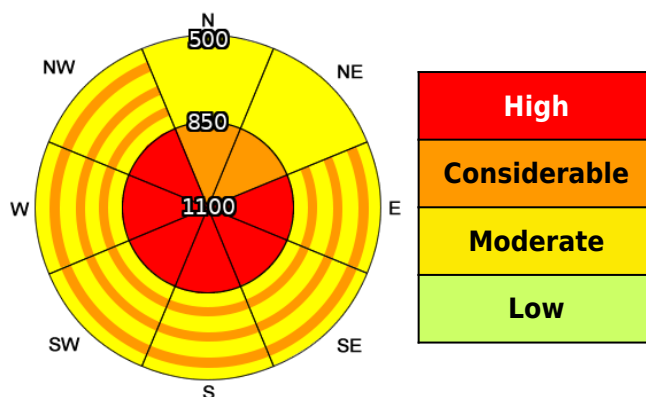


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 31/03/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large unstable accumulations of fresh windslab will form mainly on Easterly through South to North-Westerly aspects where avalanches will occur. Other aspects will be affected due to cross loading in the high winds. Corrie rims and gullies will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard is High



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will back to strong Northerly overnight and during the day and will be accompanied by prolonged heavy snow showers bringing blizzard conditions. The freezing level will be at 350 metres.

Comments

Blizzard conditions and large amounts of fresh windslab. Very wintery! Heavy falls of fresh snow likely throughout the evening and during the day.
