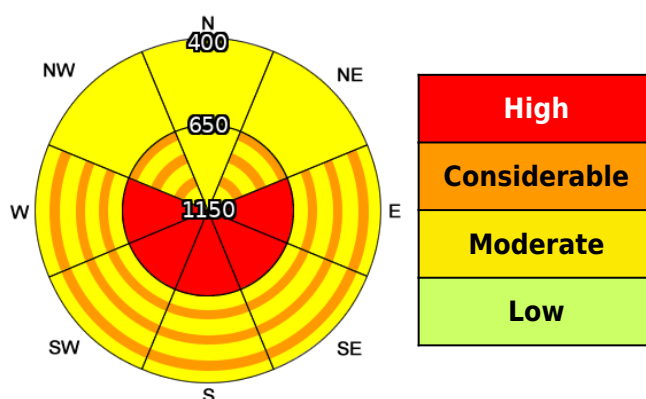

There are widespread areas of recently formed unstable wind slab. These will be concentrated on Easterly through South to Westerly aspects above 650 metres where avalanches will occur. Smaller terrain features will be cross loaded on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Storm conditions with snow, strong North-West winds and low freezing levels will continue through the night.

Comments

There were foot (body) penetrations in the storm snow of 170cm by Braemar Mountain Rescue Team out on a rescue last night/morning. Huge amounts of snow available for further re-distribution.
