

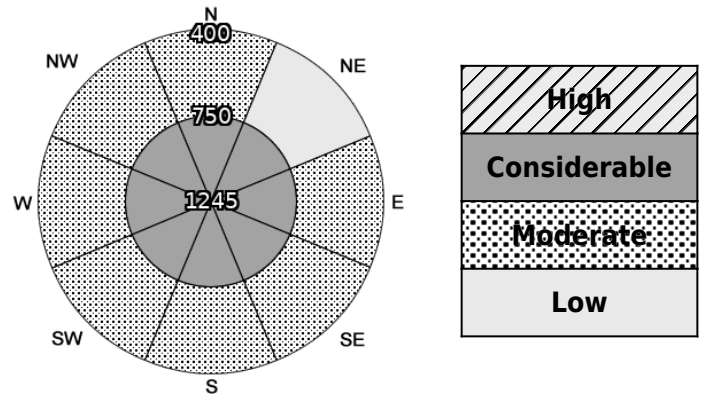
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 02/04/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow will be redistributed overnight and new accumulations will form unstable windslab on North to Easterly aspects mainly above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. Additionally, unstable windslab will remain present on all other aspects and especially on steep slopes, convexities, gully flanks and exits. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be dry with moderate South-Westerly winds which will lessen in the day and become light Southerly. The freezing level will be at 550 metres during the day.
