

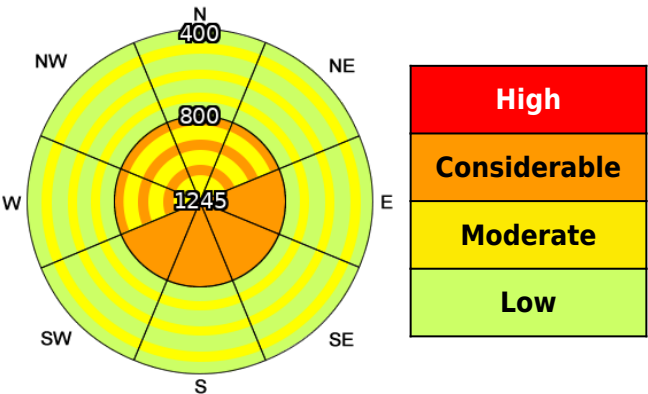

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will lead to new accumulations of weakly bonded windslab developing on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. Localised weaknesses will affect all other aspects especially in areas of steep terrain. Elsewhere the snowpack will be moderately well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be snow showers on moderate North-North-West winds. During Sunday the winds will back and decrease to the West. The freezing level will rise to 800 metres.

Comments

Winds will strengthen to SSW during Sunday evening, stormy conditions for Easter Monday.
