

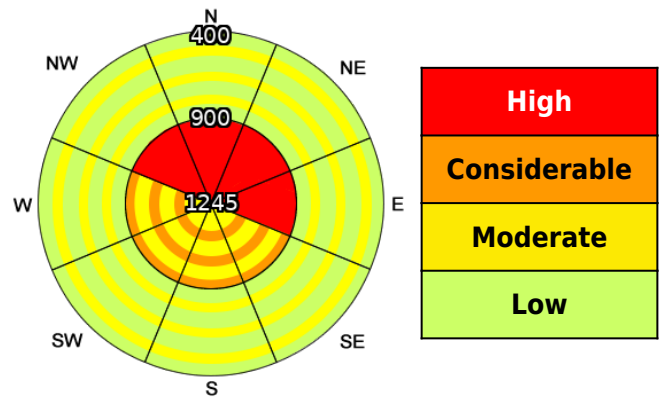
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 05/04/2010

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Before the temperature rise drifting will take place at higher altitudes, this will load lee slopes. Avalanches will occur mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Most other aspects will be affected by instabilities especially in steep and convex terrain. Cornices will weaken and be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will be followed by rain at all levels as the freezing level rises from 1000 to 2000 metres early on Monday morning. The winds will be strong Southerly veering South-South-Westerly.

#### Comments

Instabilities most prominent during the temperature rise.
