



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some new slab develop on Northerly quarter aspects above 600 metres. In the cooling trend the new snow will bond reasonably well to the old moist surface. Cornice and ground release avalanches continue to be a concern. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be some cooling with decreasing winds from the South-west. Rain will ease with snow showers down to 600 metres.
