

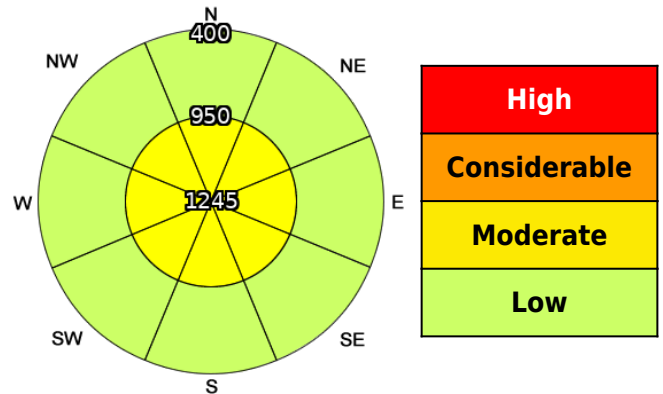

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 07/04/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack at all levels will consolidate in the cooler temperatures and slowly stabilise. Some new isolated snow accumulations will form localised moderately bonded windslab in sheltered hollows, gully exits and corrie rims on mainly North to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. Cornices will remain unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will be at 900 metres and the winds will be moderate South-Westerly with very light snow showers. In the day the freezing level will be at 1000 metres and the South-West winds will strengthen slightly. Snow showers expected later in the day.

Comments

Cooler temps ahead should halt the thaw.
