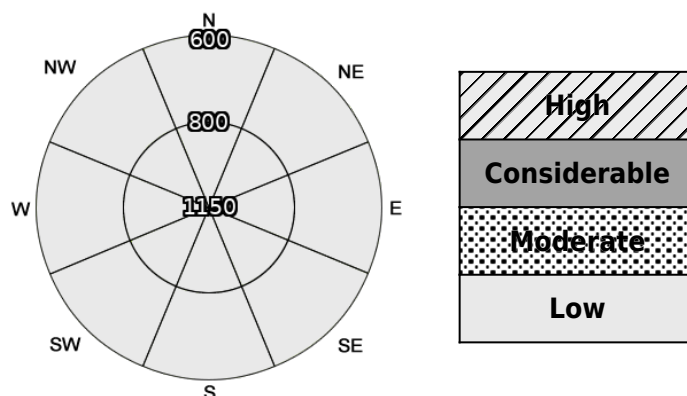


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 08/04/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Small accumulations of wet snow may develop on North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres but in general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in all locations. Cornices will be weak and prone to collapse in the mild temperatures. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be some light sleet on moderate Westerly winds. The freezing level will be at around 1100 metres.

Comments

Main hazard is mild temperatures leading to cornice collapse and rock fall, still potential for some full depth slides especially in areas of steep grassy terrain.
