

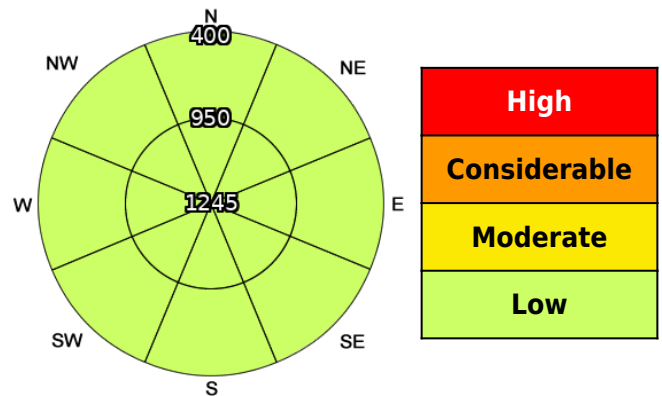

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Any new snow should bond well to the old snow surface. The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. Some surface sluffs may occur on the steepest slopes in the warm temperatures or on sunny aspects. Cornices will remain unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the winds will be moderate Westerly and some light sleety showers are expected. The freezing level will be at 900 metres in the day having dropped from 1200 metres in the night.
