

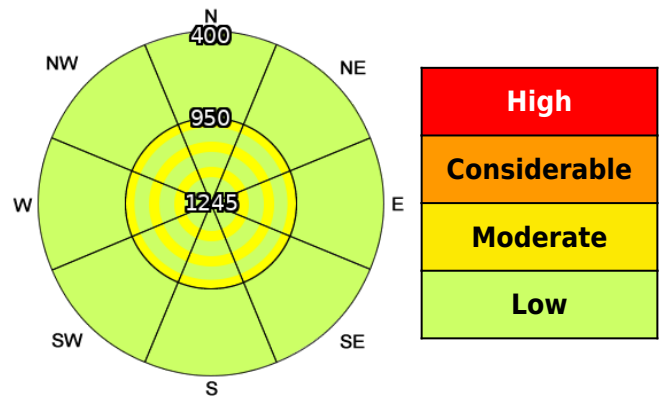

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack at all levels and on all aspects will continue thaw and soften but will remain generally stable. On steep slopes, on all aspects surface sluffing may occur in the warm temperatures. Cornices will remain unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the winds will be dry moderate West-North-Westerly. In the day the winds will become light Westerly then South-Westerly and the freezing level will be above summit levels.

Comments

Soft snow- cornice collapse and rockfall threat in corries and below crags.
