

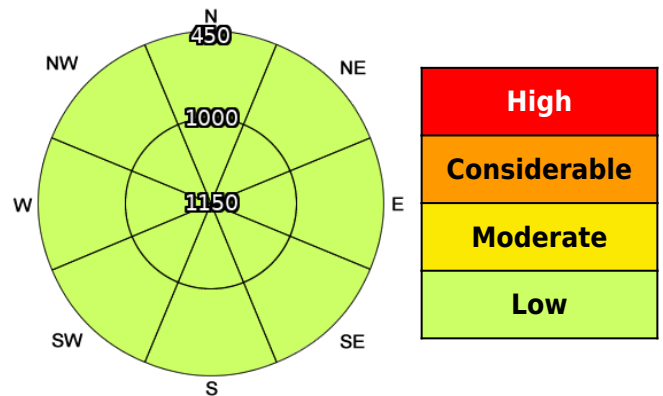

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 10/04/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally stable on all but the very steepest slopes, where rising daytime temperatures will soften the snow and form surface weaknesses. Areas most affected will be summit gully exits and corniced areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and settled with freezing levels hovering around 1100 to 1200 metres. Winds will be fresh from a South-Westerly direction.

Comments

Mild dry and settled outlook. Cornices prone to collapse with rising daytime temps.
