



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 11/04/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally stable in most areas; however steep terrain and sun-exposed slopes will be affected by surface instabilities. Cornices will remain weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry settled conditions will continue with light variable winds. The freezing level will be well above the summits.
