

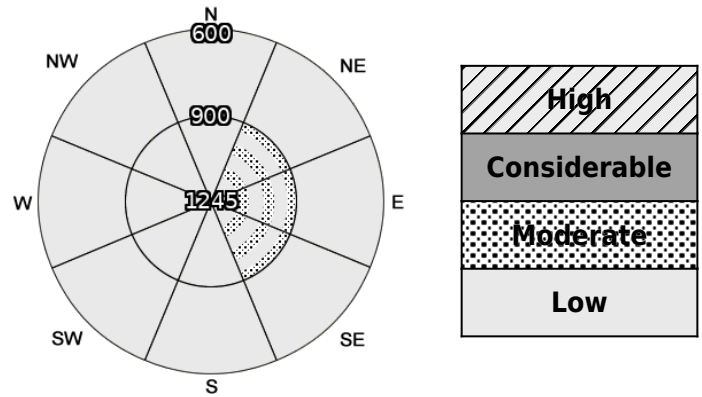

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 17/04/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will generally be well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. However, later in the day new deposits of fresh snow will form localised accumulations of windslab mainly above 900 metres on North-East to South-Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be dry with strong Westerly winds. During the day it will gradually get colder with the freezing level falling to 1000 metres. Some snow is expected later in the afternoon with the strong West-North-Westerly winds.

Comments

Good conditions - some snow expected in the day - Stone fall risk below crags.
