

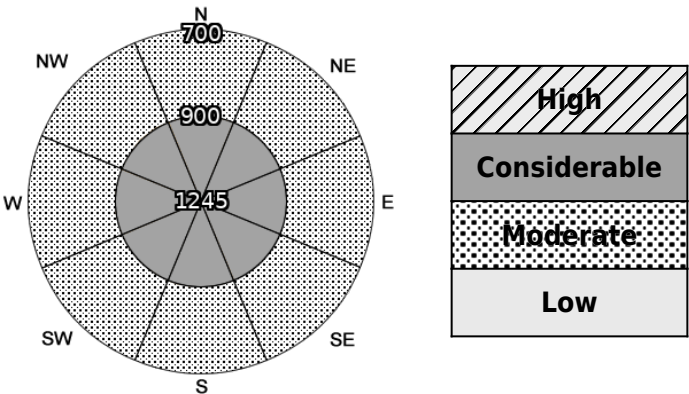

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 24/04/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack on all steep slopes will become unstable with the rising temperatures and rainfall. Surface instabilities will become more pronounced as the day progresses and surface avalanche releases are likely on most steep aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, moderate snowfall will continue lying mainly above 700 metres. Winds will be moderate South-Easterly. During the day the freezing level will rise above the summits and rain will fall at all levels with a moderate Southerly wind.

Comments

Snow will continue overnight but temperatures will rise well above the summits in the daytime with summit temperatures of +4 degrees centigrade.
