

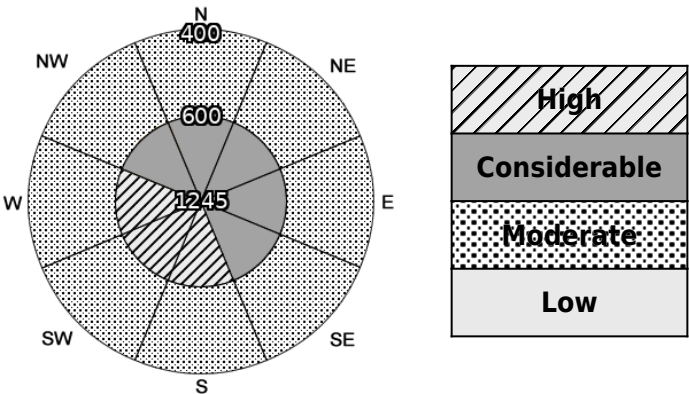

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 27/11/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain weak with poorly bonded windslab present on all aspects above 600 metres. New accumulations of windslab will weaken the snow further on mainly South to Westerly aspects above 600 metres where avalanches will occur. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, moderate North-Easterly winds with heavy snow showers are expected. During the day winds will lessen and become Northerly. Freezing at all levels.

Comments

Deep snow - windslab present on most aspects. The cold temperatures will preserve the weaknesses that exist. Remaining cold with snow.
