



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The unstable snowpack that already exists on all aspects, will be loaded further by the drifting snow, this will form weakly bonded windslab on mainly South through West to North-Westerly aspects where avalanches will occur. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the winds will be moderate to strong Easterly with continuing moderate snow showers. Freezing at all levels.

Comments

Continued snowfall and cold temperatures will maintain the current snowpack condition and hazard level. Next Avalanche report will be issued on the 4th December 2010.
