

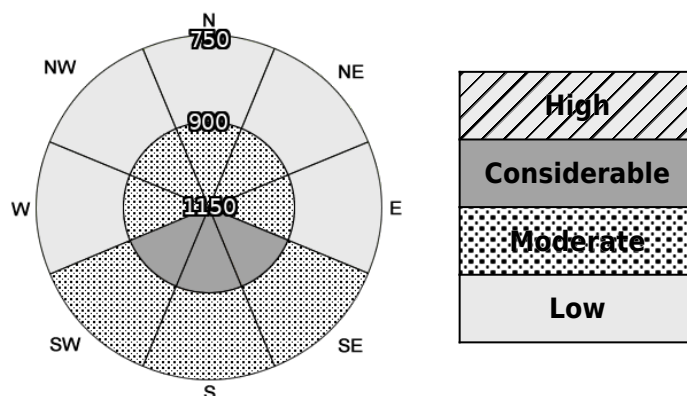

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Avalanches are likely above 900 metres on South-East to South-West aspects as new snow accumulations continue to form poorly bonded windslab. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be continued snow showers with moderate to strong North-Westerly winds. Temperatures will remain cold.

Comments

Reasonably good cover for snow sport above 750 metres. Some patchy zones still but lee gullies, scarp slopes and exit slopes need care and consideration.
