



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 17/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further accumulations of new snow will develop on all aspects. Above 850m localised instabilities will exist mostly on East to South Easterly aspects, where accumulations are greatest. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A cold North-Westerly airflow will persist, with snow showers overnight and during the day. It will remain freezing at all levels with midday temperatures down to minus 11 on the tops.

Comments

New snow instabilities developing in the cold showery NW airstream. More significant accumulation of snow overlying older isolated patches above 850m. More complete in plateau locations
