

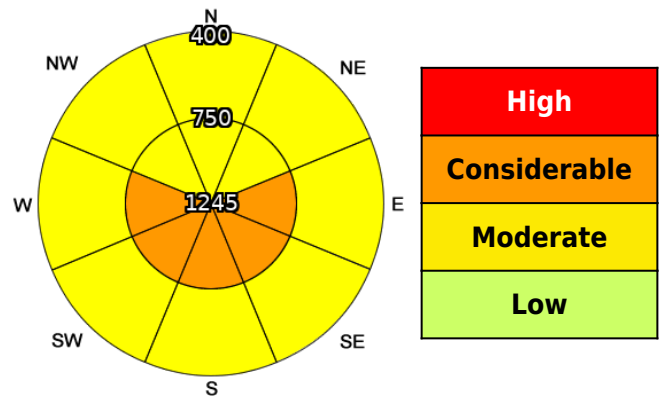

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 18/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be little change within the very cold snowpack. Weakly bonded windslab will remain on Easterly through South to Westerly aspects above 750 metres. Localised deposits will continue to affect North-West through North to North-East aspects especially around sheltered locations such as gully flanks and crag aprons. The old snowpack will remain firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will continue to be very cold and snow showers during the night will generally die out to leave a mostly fine day. Winds will be light and North-Easterly.
