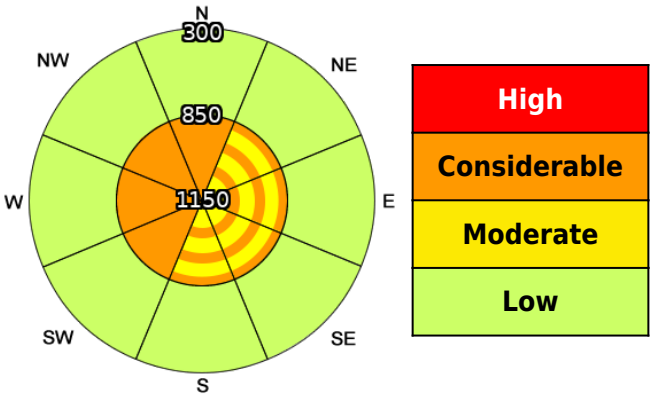


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The Easterly winds will continue to re-distribute snow into sheltered areas, developing further deposits of poorly bonded windslab. The greatest accumulations will be on South-West through West to North aspects above 850 metres. Cross loading winds will take place affecting gully exits and steep coire headwalls The avalanche hazard is Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain below freezing at all levels with light snow flurries and moderate Easterly winds.

Mainly dry with the odd snow flurry. Icy paths.
