

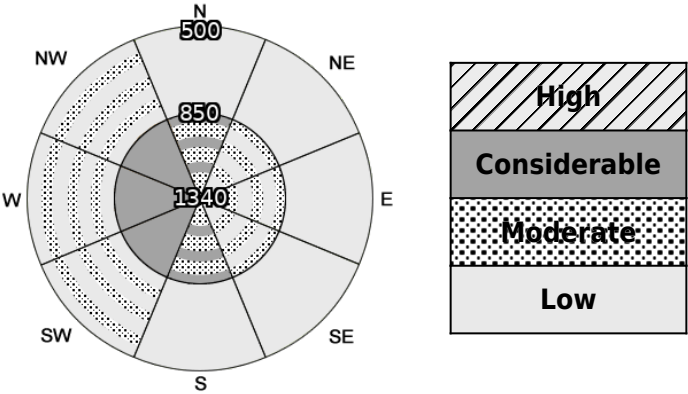

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The cold and settled conditions will maintain the instabilities within the snowpack. Areas of poorly bonded windslab will exist on South-West to North-West aspects, and in other sheltered locations, above 850 metres. Wind scoured areas will be hard and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The cold and settled weather will continue. Light North-Easterly winds will back to the North-West. Temperatures will remain below freezing.

Comments

Cold and settled conditions expected to continue for a good few days yet. Little change expected in the snowpack conditions.
