



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will maintain weaker layers in the snowpack on slopes of most aspects. Localised accumulations of marginally stabilised snow can be expected mainly at the top of steep, sheltered South to West aspects above 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain very cold with light variable, generally Northerly winds carrying light occasional snow showers.

Comments

Reasonable stability in many places but weak layers persisting in places that could catch out the unwary. Bright winter sunshine at Creag Meagaidh on Sunday.
