

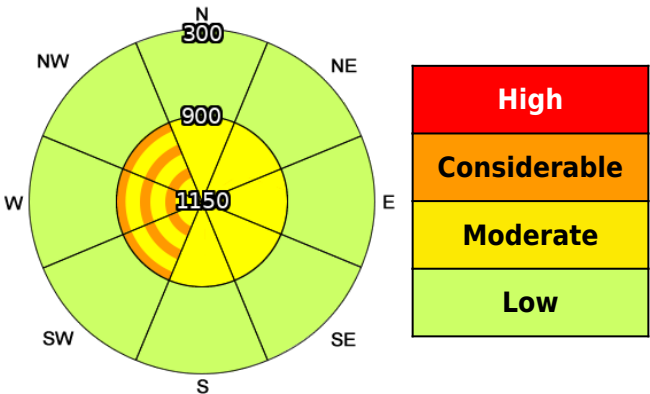

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The continuing cold conditions will maintain isolated snowpack weaknesses on South-West to North-West aspects. The light winds will re-distribute some snow onto sheltered South-East to South-West aspects mainly above 900 metres. These new deposits will be poorly bonded but will be patchy and isolated. Where these conditions exist the avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and below freezing at all levels. Light winds will back from North-East becoming North-West.
