



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Below 800 metres on all aspects the snowpack will generally be stable. Above 800 metres on all aspects localised unstable areas will persist, especially around corrie rims, in hollows and gully flanks and exits. Windslab accumulations will continue to form on mainly East to South aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the wind will remain light North-Westerly, strengthening to moderate in the day. Snow showers will continue, freezing at all levels.

Comments

Remaining cold, but poor visibility.
