

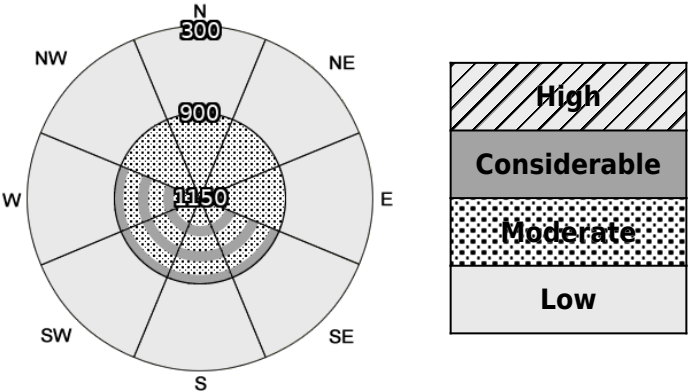

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The cold conditions will maintain existing instabilities within the snowpack. On South-East through South to West aspects localised areas of weakly bonded windslab will exist mainly above 900 metres. Sheltered gullies will also contain pockets of unstable snow deposits. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry, cold conditions will continue to affect the area. Light winds will veer from the North-West to the North and temperatures will remain below freezing.
