



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Slow consolidation will continue to take place within the existing cold snowpack. Above 800 metres the snowpack will be moderately well bonded in most areas however; localised instabilities will affect South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres mainly in areas of steep ground, corrie rims gully exits and crag aprons. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

No snowfall is expected and cold calm conditions will continue.
