

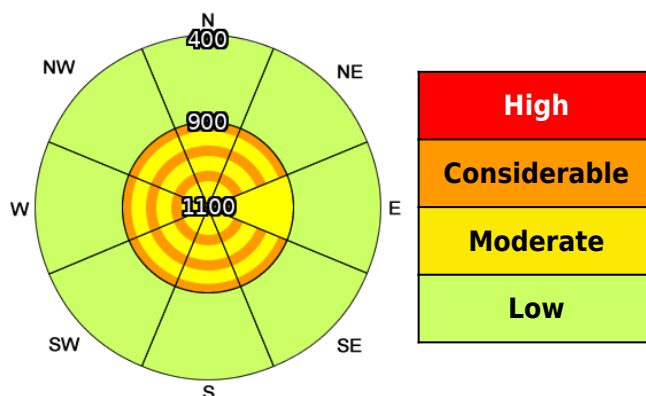
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 23/12/2010

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will maintain weaker layers in the snowpack on slopes of most aspects. Localised accumulations of marginally stabilised snow can be expected mainly, but not exclusively, at the top of steep, sheltered South-West to North West aspects above 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain very cold with light North-East winds.

#### Comments

Reasonable stability but weak layers persisting in places. Bright winter sunshine and very cold shade temperatures at Creag Meagaidh on Weds. A few good skiable lines noted but beware barely covered rocks (and deeper heather that make your skis 'submarine'!)
