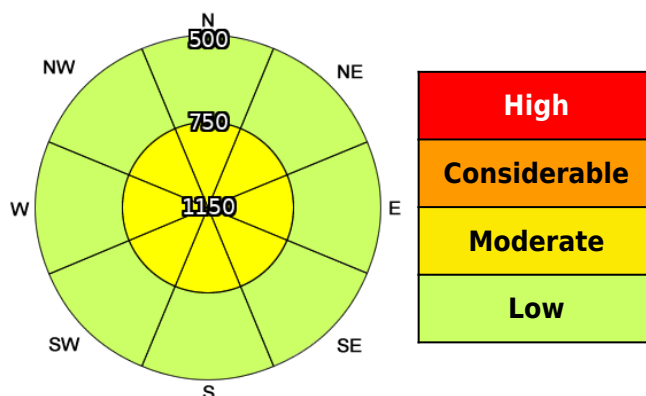


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 23/12/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Weakly bonded layers remain within the snowpack with further crystal growth expected. Isolated areas of weakly bonded slab still exist on steep unsupported convex slopes above 750 metres where human triggered avalanches are possible. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The high pressure remains with light North-Easterly winds and no precipitation. It will be exceptionally cold in low lying areas.

Comments

Exceptionally low temperatures are expected in the valley floor so lookout for frost nip on exposed skin. Isolated unstable slab still persists on steep convex slopes such as corrie rims and some gully exits, read the terrain carefully.
