

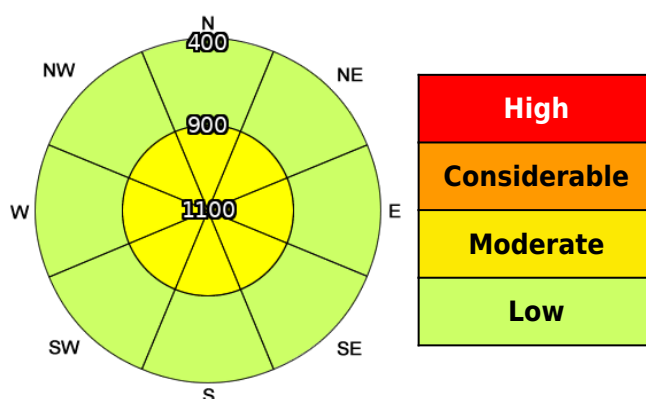

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 24/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will maintain weaker layers in the snowpack on most aspects. Some re-distribution of windblown snow is possible onto Southerly aspects with cross-loading of sheltered gully flanks. Localised accumulations of marginally stabilised snow can be expected mainly, but not exclusively, at the top of steep, sheltered South-West to North West aspects above 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with freshening Northerly winds.

Comments

Away from main drags skis barely an option below 400m. Better in plateau areas - if you can handle the limited and variable heather, surface hoar and pampas grass descent options!
