

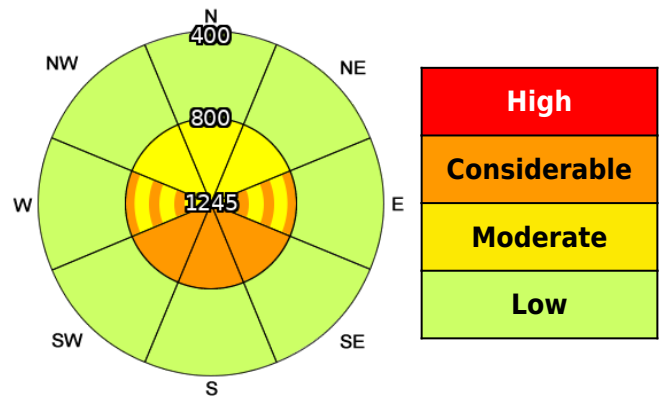

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some drifting will take place and new accumulations of windslab will develop. This will overlie the existing surface hoar leading to weaknesses within the snowpack. Areas most affected will be mainly on South-East to South-West aspects above 800 metres particularly around Corrie rims and gully tops. Below this level the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional light snow showers will cross the mountains on moderate North winds.

Comments

Steep slopes have serious run out potential due to the very hard ice disguised by the soft snow.
