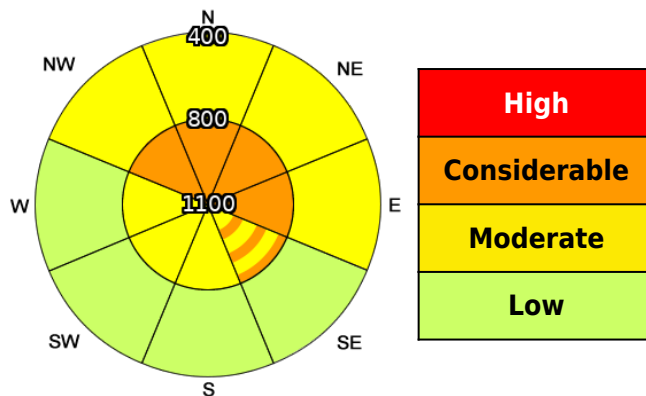


## Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 26/12/2010

### Avalanche Problems

### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will steadily decline during the day as winds re-distribute snow as windslab on to North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 800m where avalanches are likely. Slopes and gully tops directly exposed to the wind will show better stability. Considerable hazard of avalanche.



### Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold overnight with much stronger Westerly, later Southerly, winds during Sunday. Light snowfall during the day with heavier falls expected later in the period.

### Comments

Reasonable stability to start but declining rapidly as wind speeds increase - significant transport of snow expected later in the day.
