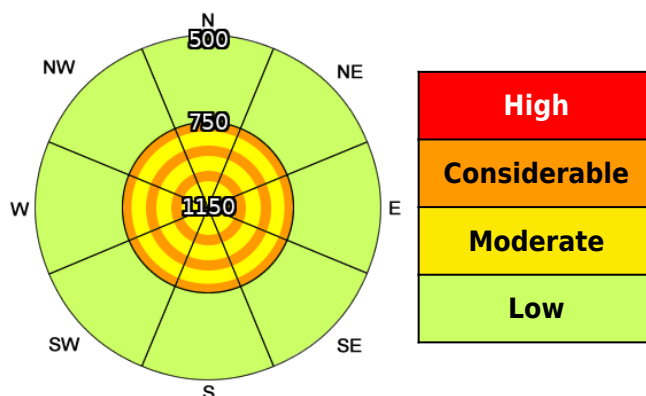


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 26/12/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be isolated pockets of instability forming due to wind direction change, and new, poorly bonded windslab snow forming onto buried surface hoar layers, especially in lee areas on mainly North-West through North to Easterly aspects, other aspects will also present localised instabilities. Avalanches are likely on all aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Sunday will be a transitional day, with a trend to warmer temperatures. Some snow is expected later in the day with moderate Westerly and Southerly winds.
