

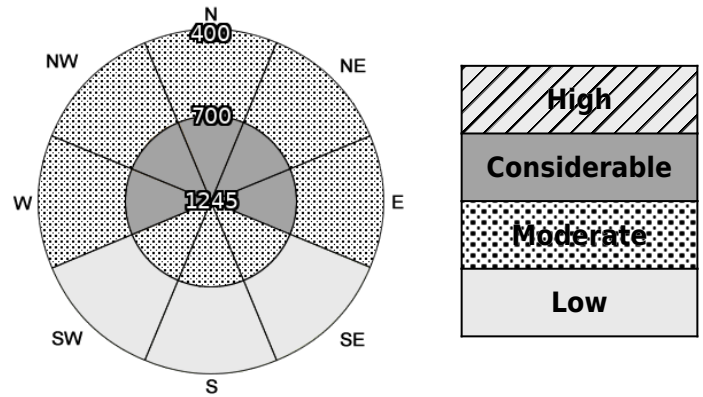

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 27/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting snow will continue to form unstable windslab on West through North to Easterly aspects mainly above 700 metres where avalanches are likely, sheltered locations, corrie rims and gully exits in North facing corries will be especially affected. Below 700 m on many aspects stable, refrozen snowpack is evident. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day winds will be strong Southerly. Snow showers overnight will become light occasional in the day. The freezing level will rise to 400 metres in the day.

Comments

A changing situation with new weak windslab forming on many aspects and locations due to strong W - S winds. Good route finding and awareness skills are useful.
