

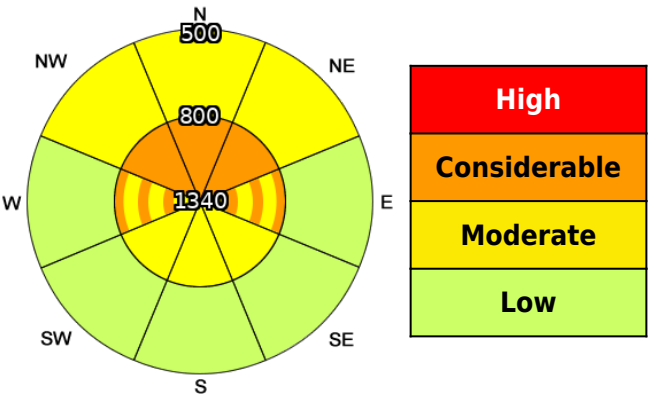

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 27/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Soft poorly bonded windslab will continue to be deposited on mainly North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Patches of windslab will also form on other aspects due to cross loading. Fresh cornices will be soft and prone to collapse. Where scoured by the wind the snowapck will be firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow is expected to become light and patchy through the day. Moderate winds will be from the South, with the freezing level rising to around 500 metres.
