

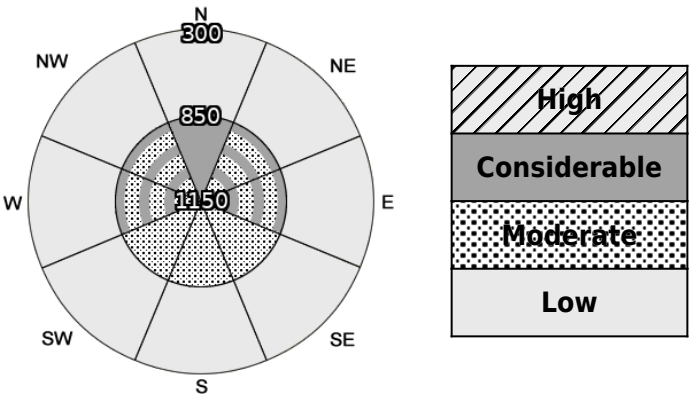

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly bonded windslab will continue developing in many sheltered locations and especially sheltered gullies. The greatest deposits will be on North-West to North-East aspects and mainly above 850 metres where avalanches are likely. Other slope aspects have isolated instabilities. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers on strong South-Easterly winds are expected. The freezing level will be around 300 metres.

Plenty of frozen water courses still exist albeit they are becoming moist.
