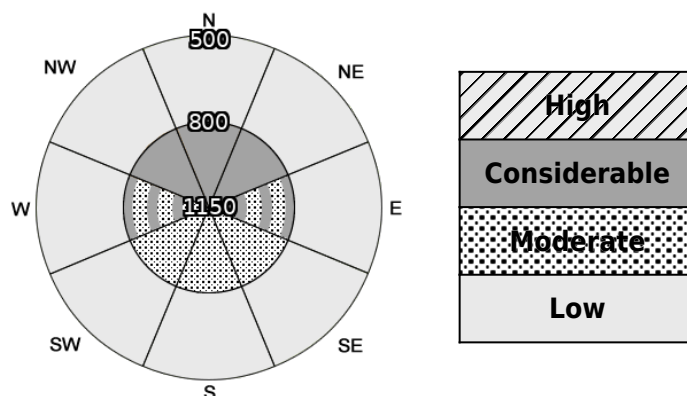


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 29/12/2010****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

As the thaw conditions become established the snowpack will become increasingly unstable. Avalanches are likely on North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Stability will also be poor in the localised deposits that exist on some East and West aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a dry day with moderate winds. The freezing level will rise above the summits with a maximum temperature of +5 degrees centigrade forecast for 900 metres.
