



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 29/12/2010

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will remain mainly on steep North-West through North to East aspects above about 900 metres. At lower levels the snowpack will continue to consolidate. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable. Cornice stability will decline in the thawing conditions.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry, with strong Southerly winds decreasing to moderate during the day. The freezing level is expected to rise from around 1000 metres overnight to above the summits during the day.

Comments

Water ice remains on many paths and hill sides.
