

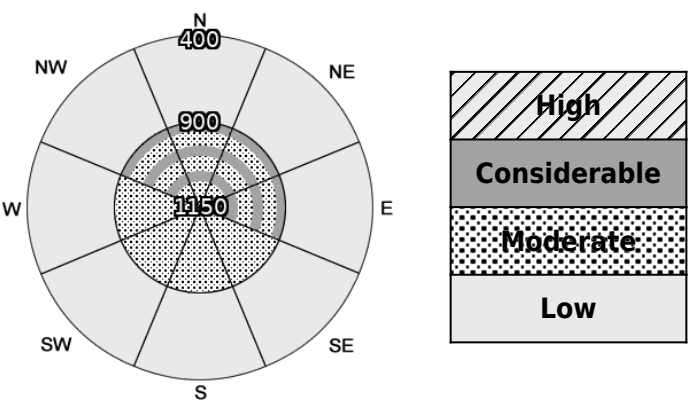

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Generally the snowpack will be moderately well bonded on most aspects but localised areas of instabilities will exist, mainly on North-West through to North-East aspects and above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable. As temperatures fall during the day snowpack stability is expected to improve above 1000 metres.



Forecast Weather Influences

The dry conditions will prevail, overnight winds will be from the South these will veer to the North-West during the day. The freezing level will lower to 1200 metres.

Comments

Mild conditions are affecting the area but many lower water ice routes are hanging in.
