

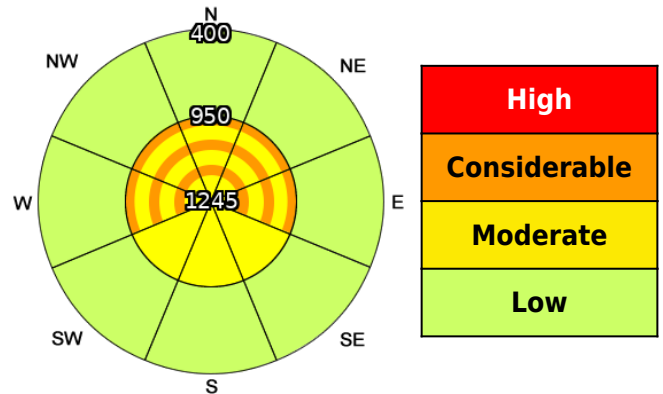
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 30/12/2010

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw. Some localised instabilities will affect West through North to East aspects above 950 metres mainly in areas of steep terrain, Corrie rims and gully heads. Cornices will be weak and prone to collapse; however in general snowpack stability will improve in the slightly cooler temperatures and be moderately well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will lead to dry conditions with light Southerly winds veering to the North-West. The freezing level will lower to 1200 metres during the day.

#### Comments

Serious run out potential on steep scoured slopes due to very hard surface layer of old ice.
