

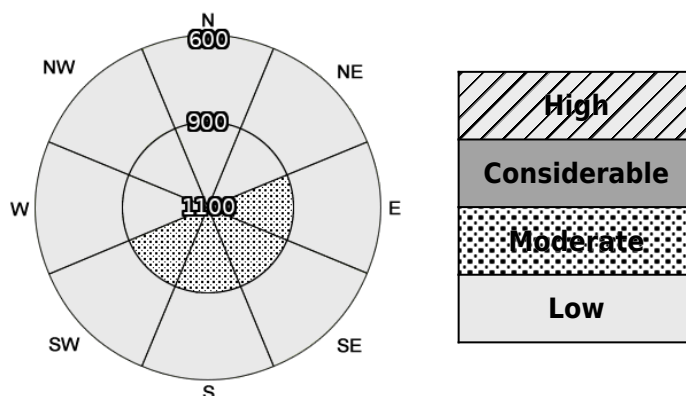

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 01/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A crust will begin to develop in many locations as the freezing level falls close to glen level. Near surface layers of snow will show better consolidation in cooler, drier conditions although thin accumulations of new, marginally stabilised windslab may form on steep East through South to South-West aspects above 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming colder with North-West, later Northerly winds and a brief period of sleety snow.
